For 2021/22, Brockenhurst College is introducing passes for shorter periods. Similar to the HT passes offered for the 2020/21 academic year, there is no full year commitment and purchasing a pass for the subsequent period is optional (pricing for Full Academic Year (FAY) passes, including Early Bird rates and instalments, can be found on the reverse).

Period passes are sold as stand alone passes and are not offered with a Recurring Card Payment (RCP) plan (i.e. payment must be made manually when renewing each period). **Period passes deactivate at the end of their period of validity (except where a pass for the subsequent period has been purchased).**

Where a pass for the subsequent period is **not** purchased by the payment deadline, the pass will deactivate and cease to be valid on either College or public bus services (e.g. where a pass for travel 11/10/21 - 12/11/21 is not purchased by 06/10/21, the original pass will deactivate 08/10/21) with a replacement pass issued if payment is subsequently received. **Where payment is made by the due date (below), the original Key is retained and should be used for the following**

All passes are purchased through the College's online BrockShop. The BrockShop is accessed via the Student Portal (<https://students.brock.ac.uk/>) and applicants can sign into the portal pre-enrolment using their DOB and Student ID #.

Where payment for the 05/01/22 - 04/02/22 period is made by 14/12/21, the retained pass will also be valid for public service use over the 'Christmas' break (17/12/21 - 04/01/22). Where payment is not received, the original pass will deactivate 16/12/21 and a replacement pass (if a pass for the subsequent period is purchased pre-03/01/22) will be issued for travel 05/01/22 onward. The same applies to the 'Easter' break (09/04/22 - 24/04/22) with public service validity extended where payment is received by 07/04/22 for the 25/04/22 - 27/05/22 period (full details on the BrockShop).

Our bus service provider - Go South Coast (GSC) - offer purchasers of a College bus pass the flexibility of travelling outside of College bus times. **Period passes are valid for travel (incl. evening and weekend use) on GSC's BlueStar 6, 8 & 9 and MoreBus X1/X2, X3 & X6 public services during their stated period of validity** (e.g. 06/09/2021 - 07/10/2021). Public service use is not factored into the price of College passes and must be secondary to College service use (i.e. Brockenhurst College does not sell passes for use exclusively on public services).

Brockenhurst College offers subsidised travel passes to learners on a full academic year (FAY) basis with the option to spread the cost of FAY passes through affordable instalments at no extra charge (dates below).

An Early Bird (EB) discount applies where payment is made in full in advance of 01/09/2021 (FAY passes only) and passes for shorter, fixed periods are also available for purchase (see reverse for more information).

All passes are purchased through the College's online BrockShop. The BrockShop is accessed via the Student Portal (<https://students.brock.ac.uk/>) and applicants can sign into the portal pre-enrolment using their DOB and Student ID #.

We advise payment be made no later than 20/08/2021 for delivery pre-06/09/2021. Bus passes are produced externally and, where possible, posted directly to learners in advance of enrolment. Passes can also be collected direct from Brockenhurst College upon request (post-enrolment).

Bus passes are priced on 5 zones - please see table to left for most of our currently serviced areas. If you cannot find your area to the left please refer to the travel map on the Student Portal for relevant zone.
